- 1. All care will be taken with exhibits BUT responsibility for insurance rests with the exhibitor.
- **2.** Exhibitor to list all entries on Handcraft Entry Form.
- **3.** Entries must not be more than two years old and the item/s must be the exhibitors own work.
- **4.** OPEN classes are for previous winners as well as any other entrant choosing to enter.
- **5.** NOVICE classes are for those who have not won a prize in that class previously.
- **6.** The stewards reserve the right to move an exhibit to another category if, in the judge's opinion, the exhibit is incorrectly placed.
- **7.** The stewards reserve the right to combine categories if insufficient entries received in those categories.
- **8.** Exhibits will be judged on creativity, design, colour, durability, usability, practicality, and suitability of materials used. Cleanliness is essential.
- **9.** Papercraft: FLAT entries must be presented in a plastic sleeve.
- **10.** Prizes are awarded at the judge's discretion.
- Specific articles which have previously gained prizes in a Stanthorpe Show are excluded from entry.
- **12.** Only 2 items per class unless otherwise stated.

Any design, fabric, medium. Maximum size 50cm x 50cm. Your entry will be Judged by public vote.

An item made by a child aged 5yrs and 12 yrs. Must be suitable for a wall display and able to be hung. Any fabric can be used. Size is limited to maximum 30 x 30 cm.

The maximum weight required is 500 grams. Your entry will be Judged by public vote.

Q13 Felt craft

Any item, including brooches/necklaces Max. height 30 cms – max. shelf space A5.

Q14 Garden ornament

A rustic item using any weatherproof materials. e.g. nails, spoons, wire, nuts, bolts and your imagination! Max. size $30 \times 30 \times 30$ cm.

Q15 Gift boxes

Box to be fully handmade using origami/paper/stiff card and decorated – we suggest going to Pinterest or Google for more ideas. Max. size of base equal to A5.

Q16 Hair accessories

e.g. decorated hair bands, scrunchies, combs.

Q17 Handmade flowers

Presentation is part of the judging e.g. present as a posy, in a small vase - max. height 30cms, or an interesting bunch. This craft is enjoying renewed interest, Pinterest or Google could help.

Q18 Jewellery item

Must be mounted ready for display. Max. shelf space A5. Prizes *donated by Market in the Mountains*.
