## CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

1. All exhibits to be in the hands of the stewards between **6.00pm - 8.00pm on Thursday 31<sup>st</sup> January and Friday 1<sup>st</sup> February between 8.00am - 10.00am**. All exhibits to be staged by 10:30am. Exhibitors to leave the area for judging.
2. Judging to commence 10:30am.
3. All exhibits other than flowers arranged for effect, must be grown by the exhibitor.
4. **Entry fee: 50c per entry with a CAP of \$25.** Allocation of prizes will only be made to those entries deemed worthy of a prize by the judge. The judge's decision shall be deemed final.
5. If an exhibit has been placed in the wrong class, the judge may direct the steward to place the exhibit in the correct class and re-judge that class.
6. GST implications are as those listed in the front of the schedule.
7. Entries will be available for collection from 4pm Saturday 2<sup>nd</sup> February.

## DEFINITIONS

1. **Bowl** is defined as a circular or oval vessel whose smallest diameter measures across the top more than the height.
2. A **trough** is defined as a "narrow receptacle whose length is greater than the width".
3. A **collection** is judged on quality, freshness and variety, not quantity of any variety.
4. A **container** is defined as any vessel that can be used for an arrangement.
5. **Distinct** means each bloom must be different.
6. Exhibitors where possible to exhibit cut flowers in green bottles – particularly Dahlias and Roses. Not painted bottles. Green wine bottles are suitable.

### **Accessories allowed with any arrangement**

- Accessories including bases, drapes, containers, title cards & mechanics are permitted with any arrangement.
- All arrangements must have natural plant material predominating.
- All fresh plant material must be staged with cut ends in water or water retaining material (e.g. florist foam), unless the plant material will remain in a satisfactory condition for the duration of the show.
- Due to current space constraints, exhibitors are encouraged to keep their arrangements to less than 50cm wide and 35cm deep when staged.
