Open to all breeds and riders

Two phases: 1) work pattern and 2) cattle section.

Overall highest points: 1st \$330.00, 2nd \$250.00, 3rd

Cattle section:

- On completion of dry work, one beast will be released.
- 2. Work beast on end of arena to show ability of the horse to hold the beast.

- Complete a circle in each direction to the best of your ability.
