3. All exhibits to be grown by exhibitor.
4. All cartons to be branded for the market in conformity with state regulations.
5. Each competitor shall mark on the end of his/her carton or tray, the class and exhibit number and the steward will also tack on the top portion of the card supplied showing the class and exhibit no.
6. The judges have the privilege of using one or more fruits in any exhibit for cutting up etc and will use their own discretion in the awarding of prizes.
7. Those exhibits approaching perfect uniformity of both size and form will have the best chance of obtaining maximum points awarded.
8. No unauthorised person will be allowed in the pavilion whilst judging is taking place.
