

- TICKET SYSTEM OF ENTRY TO RING: The ring office will be open from 8.30am on Friday and from 7.30am on Saturday. All tickets must be purchased from the ring office (alongside the Broadcast Box) and filled in by competitor and presented to a Steward before the judging of a Class commences. NO REFUNDS WILL BE GIVEN
- HORSE HEALTH DECLARATION: horse exhibitors must complete a horse health declaration and present to Ring Office when purchasing entry tickets.
- HORSE STALLS: Horse stalls must be used if available. Are available for \$10.00 per covered stall for the duration of the show. PLEASE INDICATE IF YOU ARE A HACK OR SHOWIUMPING **COMPETITOR.** All stall bookings must be made on the form provided, through the Secretary and paid for in advance. Names and stable numbers will be stapled to each stall prior to the show. ALL STALLS MUST BE PAID FOR - NO REFUNDS


