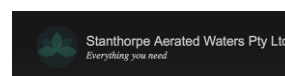

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

1. All entries must be recent (within two years) and be the original, unaided work of the exhibitor, (not copied) and not previously exhibited in a Stanthorpe Show. **No single work may be entered in more than one class.**
2. **Works in all classes must be ready for hanging** and have the following clearly marked on the reverse of the work: **Artist's Name, address, title of work, class, medium, and sale price or N.F.S.** (Not for sale). 25% commission on sales is payable to the Stanthorpe Agricultural Society.
3. **The stewards reserve the right to reject any work not ready for hanging.**
4. **The Judge's decision is final; if the standard of work in any class is deemed to be insufficient, the judge may not award all prizes.**
5. Works may be accepted for display only or for sale at the **chief steward's discretion.**
6. Fill in section M entry form and deliver works plus entry fees to the **Tea Pavilion** at the showgrounds between **9am and 12pm Sunday 20th January and 4pm and 6pm Thursday 24th January 2019.**
7. Exhibitors need to advise stewards on entry if they wish to be included in the judging for the *Indigenous Art Awards, Jean Harslett Memorial Award or the Emerging Artist Award.*
8. The presentation of prizes will be held at a function at **6.30pm for 7pm on Thursday 31st January** in the Tea Pavilion – all exhibitors and friends are welcome to attend. **RSVP** appreciated.
9. **All artwork**, including works sold during the show will be available for **collection between 4pm – 6pm Monday 4th February and 9am – 12noon Sunday 10th February.**
10. All prizes not collected at the presentation will be available at the Showgrounds Office.
